100 clothing-care kits being donated through shopping event for Lowcountry Orphan Relief

NORTH CHARLESTON, S.C. (WCIV) — Dozens of children in need will be receiving help through a collaboration between several Lowcountry groups.

Suburban Propane, Tanger Outlets and the Charleston RiverDogs have teamed up to assemble and donate 100 clothing-care kits through a shopping event that will benefit Lowcountry Orphan Relief.

The nonprofit works to provide goods and services to children who have been abused or neglected, a press release explained.

On Monday, volunteers, participating partners and local college athletes will come together at Tanger Outlets in North Charleston to purchase clothing and other essentials for kids aged 5-18.

"This initiative is part of the SuburbanCares brand pillar, designed to assist in community efforts across the United States," the release added.
